What: Marine Life Inventory (MLI) is a great opportunity for students and their families to take an active part in marine monitoring and conservation. There will be three different stations pulling from different ecosystems in Upper Newport Bay: Beach Seine, Bottom Trawl & Plankton Tow, and Mud Grab & Water Quality. Each station will identify, count, and measure every organism found just as a real marine scientist would do!
