Dear Neighbor,

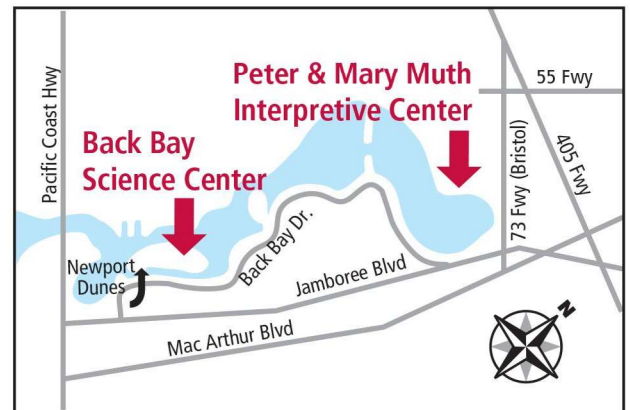
