The Board voted to hire Deanna Descovi as a temporary employee in a financial specialist role to restructure the Bay's accounting systems and processes in preparation for financial audits. Unanimously approved via email.

The Board discussed the 2026 Spirit Run. Motion to accept Newport Mesa Spirit Run, Inc.'s (NMSRI) invitation for Newport Bay Conservancy (NBC) to be a beneficiary of the 2026 Spirit Run, as proposed by NMSRI at the August and September Board Meetings, and in return for NBC (1) to host the run at the Bay, (2) to assist NMSRI in obtaining the necessary permits required by OC Parks, Fish and Wildlife, and other government agencies aside from the City of Newport Beach, (3) to assist NMSRI in obtaining permission from the Dunes and/or the Hyatt to use their parking lots for the expo and finish line area and event parking; and (4) in good faith, to consult in planning the event in the most environmentally friendly way possible. Approval of this motion is subject to NMSRI's board's reciprocal acceptance of the foregoing clause (3). Mario moved to approve NBC hosting the 2026 Spirit Run as discussed; Molly seconded; Unanimously approved.
